The Dean of the Schools of Nursing reports directly to the Provost and serves as a member of the Provost's Council at Auburn University. On the Auburn University Montgomery campus, the Dean reports to the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs and serves as a member of the Dean's Council. The Dean works collaboratively with the academic colleges and schools to provide visionary leadership to enhance and promote existing programs, to develop innovative new programs and to recruit high-quality students. Working with Auburn University's president, and Auburn University Montgomery's chancellor, the Dean will be instrumental in shaping and executing both campuses' strategic plan.

The successful candidate will be nationally recognized with demonstrated leadership in teaching, research, and public service. S/he will have a Master's degree in nursing and an earned doctorate in nursing or a related field and must be eligible for licensure in the state of Alabama; have evidence of scholarly activity commensurate with appointment as a tenured Professor; and provide evidence of successful teaching, ability to communicate effectively, substantial administrative experience and demonstrated commitment to diversity. It is preferred that the candidate possess successful administrative experience at the university, college or departmental level and successful professional experience with one or more of the following: distance education and innovative delivery models, international programs, cross-disciplinary programs, assessment and grant writing.

Review of applications will continue until the position is filled. The candidate selected for this position must be able to meet eligibility requirements to work in the United States at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally for the proposed term of employment. Excellent communication skills are required.
