The Counselor – Multicultural Specialist will provide clinical services including intake, assessment, crisis intervention, short-term individual counseling and referral to college students. Services will also include consultation and outreach to the college community through the development of programs related to cultural adjustment and diversity toward meeting the needs of a multicultural population. Participate on committees, collaborate and consult with administrators, faculty and students on issues/programs related to diversity awareness on campus. Some evenings and weekends may be required.

Qualifications:

Master's degree in counseling or related field required. Must also be a licensed counseling professional (LICSW, LMHC, Psychologist, or equivalent) or be license-eligible within one year of hire. Minimum 3 years experience providing counseling services, with a minimum of 1 year experience with a high-risk population. Successful candidate will demonstrate strong psychological assessment/differential diagnosis skills; individual and group counseling skills; crisis intervention skills; as well as consultation and training skills. Knowledge of multicultural theories and models applicable to counseling, as well as experience working with diverse populations. Special interest in men's issues and previous experience working with men preferred. Experience providing outreach

and programming related to diversity awareness and cultural adjustment issues. Familiarity with mental health systems and resources and medical insurance eligibility requirements.
