Assistant/Associate Professor of Movement and Acting: The Theatre School at DePaul University in Chicago invites applications for the fall of 2010 for a full-time, tenure track position, teaching Movement for Actors and Acting to a diverse student body in an urban multi-cultural conservatory in both the BFA and MFA Acting Programs. Other responsibilities include directing and coaching productions, advising and service.

Qualifications: MFA or professional equivalent. The ideal candidate must have expertise in teaching methods of self-organization and expressive movement. Certification and/or significant experience in teaching Laban/Bartenieff is required. Significant experience teaching acting in a theatre training program is also necessary. Candidates must have experience in directing and be committed to collegiality, a collaborative process and continuing work in the profession. Because The Theatre School seeks faculty members who bring a critical perspective to issues of diversity and multiculturalism, candidates of color are strongly encouraged to apply.
