

## ***Director, Diversity Student Affairs and Support***

Westminster College is accepting applications for the position of Director, Diversity Student Affairs and Support. The person who holds this staff position will manage the Diversity Center and collaborate with the Associate Provost for Diversity and Global Learning to develop and/or implement (a) diversity focused programming and services for underrepresented minority, first-generation, and LGBTQ students, as well as (b) diversity focused programming for the wider college community. He or she will contribute to the diversity website; serve on the college's Diversity Council; and work with Student Life, the START Center, and Admissions and Financial Aid to implement relevant aspects of campus-wide diversity plans. This position reports to the Associate Provost for Diversity and Global Learning, collaborates as appropriate with the Director of International Student Services, and attends Student Development Staff meetings.

### **Minimum qualifications**

The successful candidate will be culturally competent and have demonstrated success working with diverse student populations. The position requires strong interpersonal and communication skills, and experience developing and implementing diversity programming and services for college-level students.

Bachelor's degree in related field, and experience working with, and developing and implementing diversity programming and services for, college-level students.

### **Preferred qualifications**

Master's degree in relevant field and three or more years of experience working with, and developing and implementing diversity programming and services for, college-level students.
