

Tenure-Track Critical Media Scholar at the University of Portland (OR)

The Communication Studies department invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Critical Media Studies to begin August 2022. The department invites candidates with expertise in critical and cultural media scholarship. We welcome applicants with interdisciplinary strengths including multiple theoretical and methodological approaches. This position is a part of a cohort hire in the disciplines of Communication Studies, Biology, Political Science, Math, and Psychology, where successful faculty candidates also will have opportunities to be involved with UP's emerging and cross-disciplinary undergraduate Ethnic Studies program. Position description: tenure-track Assistant Professor position, with duties split among teaching (3 courses per semester), research (own scholarship plus developing undergraduate and Masters-level students' research), and service, including academic advising and committee work. Valuing candidates who can demonstrate lived experience, knowledge, skills, and/or success in diversity, equity and inclusion work within or transferable to higher education, as well as interdisciplinary scholarship, teaching, and/or collaboration and experience of Ethnic Studies programs.
